

## UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO AMGeO Privacy Policy

In connection with the use of the AMGeO software, the University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration will collect your email, username, password, and any association with a research institution. The University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration will be collecting this data to verify that you are a researcher at a non-profit institution and then to email you a confirmation email with your login information so you can log in to the AMGeO software webpage and access your API key. The AMGeO software will keep your email and login information for software maintenance and user support.

The AMGeO software installer will prompt you for any necessary usernames or passwords for third party data services. The University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration will not store this information but the username and password are stored locally on your hardware. Your use of its individual account to access the Third-Party Service is subject to the terms and conditions of the Third-Party Service.

The University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration will use your API key to track the number and frequency of data requests from each Third-Party Data Service. The University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration may report the number and frequency of data requests by Licensee to third-party funders who have funded or are currently funding University's development of AMGeO but only in the aggregate with the number and frequency of data requests of all users of AMGeO.

The University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration has a legitimate reason to track and report this information to third party funders so that they can gauge community adoption of the software and web application. Tracking the uses also allows the University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration to monitor any misuse of the licensed software.

We use service cookies to remember your registration and login details for a limited period of time.

The University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration will retain the personal information described above for three years after you access the AMGeO software. The AMGeO collaboration needs this information to comply with the terms of it's funding.

The rights you have regarding the use and disclosure of your personal information depend on the nature of your relationship to the University of Colorado and applicable law. The rights to your data may include the right to be informed; the right of access to your personal data; the right to rectify any inaccurate or incomplete personal data; the right to have your personal data erased under certain circumstances; the right to request the restriction or suppression of your personal data under certain circumstances; the right of data portability; the right to object to the processing of your personal data under certain circumstances; and the right not to be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling. Depending on applicable law you may have the right to make a written request or lodge a written complaint with the University of Colorado AMGeO Collaboration or the University
